Reflection for the 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time:

I see as an aim for the Month of Creation the ongoing educating of ourselves regarding concern for Mother Earth, our common home. May be we are overburdened with all the information but really these days are a call to action. Pope Francis reminds us; “Living our vocation to be protectors of God’s handiwork is essential to a life of virtue; it is not an optional or a secondary aspect of our Christian experience.” (Laudato Si, no. 217) From today’s gospel we know that Jesus is with us when we pray and in other ways as well. “Christ Jesus ...is present in many ways to his Church; in his word, in his Church’s prayer, “where two or three are gathered in my name,” in the poor, in the sick and the imprisoned, in the sacraments of which he is author, in the Sacrifice of the Mass, and in the person of the minister, But ‘he is present...most especially in the Eucharistic species.’” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1373.) Our praying must lead to action particularly in reconciling people with the Church and therefore closer to Christ.

Environmental Degradation Facts

- 27% of our coral reefs have been destroyed. If the rate continues, remaining 60% will be gone in 30 years.
- We are using up 50% more natural resources than the Earth can provide. At our current population, we need 1.5 Earths, which we do not have.
- Every hour, 1,692 acres of productive dry land become desert
- We have a garbage island floating in our ocean, mostly comprised of plastics - the size of India, Europe and Mexico combined!
