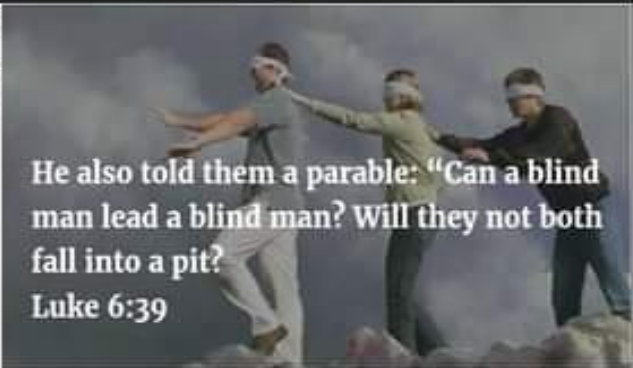

YEAR C 8TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 27TH FEBRUARY 2022

INTRODUCTION: The third and final section of Luke's Sermon on the Plain begins: And he told them a parable. There are actually four parables, three of which we read today. They are all about how to be a good disciple.

FIRST READING: *Sirach 27:4-7*
In his conversation is the test of the man.




He also told them a parable: "Can a blind man lead a blind man? Will they not both fall into a pit?"
Luke 6:39

SECOND READING: *1 Corinthians 15: 54-58*
Thanks be to God who has given us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

GOSPEL: *Luke 6:39-45*
Each tree is known by its yield.

REFLECTION:
The blind cannot lead the blind. And a disciple cannot be a good disciple unless he or she has learned from the teacher. Everyone who is fully trained is like the teacher who knows how to cure the blind. Before you can be a good disciple and teach others you must take care of yourself. Do not try to take a speck out of your brother's eye until you have taken the board out of your own. Finally, only when you have purified yourself can you produce the good works that the teacher requires. Discipleship asks us to produce good deeds. But to produce them requires the integrity and purity of heart found in the teacher. When people see your good deeds they will know that this is because you have a good heart. Our life shows what type of fruit we produce. In the light of these imageries, are we living the life that God expects of us?
